CATEGORIES

OPEN CLASSES

Class 1 **2 Tier or More Wedding Cake** – 2 Cakes or more to be tiered or otherwise presented on a common baseboard.

Class 2 **Special Occasion Cake** – 1 Cake Only (Engagement, 21st Anniversary, Christening ect.)

Class 3 **Sugarcraft** – No cake needed. Floral arrangement or novelty, an imaginative creation on base board no larger than 42cm x 42cm.

Class 4 **Novelty Cake** – An imaginative creation in any shape and design formed from cake.

INTERMEDIATE CLASSES

Class 5 **Special Occasion Cake** – 1 Cake Only (Engagement, 21st Anniversary, Christening ect.)

NOVICE CLASSES

Exhibitors who have been decorating for 3 years or less and who have NOT previously won a prize at this Show.

Class 6 **Special Occasion Cake** – 1 Cake Only (Engagement, 21st Anniversary, Christening ect.)

JUNIOR CLASSES

School students aged 12 years & under

Class 7 **Special Occasion Cake** – 1 Cake Only (Engagement, 21st Anniversary, Christening ect.)

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All exhibits must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor. Lace and extension work are not mandatory. However, a variety of piping skills within the bounds of good taste must be executed.
2. Boards or other suitable bases to be no larger than 42cm x 42cm except Class 1, where the size may be up to 55cm square.
3. Except where specifically otherwise mentioned, no non-sugar ornaments are allowed. Reasonable use of wire, tape, stamen, ribbon, cotton, tulle is permitted, and pillars or other means of elevating cakes are permitted. Minimal amount of dried vegetable matter may be used for stems or stamens. No pins are allowed to hold ribbons, etc, and no artificial paper and fabric leaves or flowers to be used. Cakes or dummies may be used. Failure to comply will result in the exhibit being ineligible for a prize. Cleats to be used under boards. Limited use of gold and silver paint. Classes 2,5,6,: Inscription on cake to specify occasion.
4. All cakes will have exhibitor's names displayed after judging.
5. Late entries or exhibits may be accepted at the discretion of the chief steward.
6. Intermediate section is for competitors who have not won a first prize in this section or any prize in corresponding open section.
7. Cakes to be for sale if desired.
8. Judges are entitled to withhold awarding a prize in any class where exhibits have not reached the standard required.
9. The judges decision will be final, except that the Committee reserves the right to consider a protest lodged in accordance with the Society's conditions.

All Competitors enter these events at their own risk. Neither the Organising Committee, Mt Gravatt Show Society, Mt Gravatt Showgrounds nor the owners of the property accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to owners, grounds, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.
