THEMED CLASS

Any article showing needlework and meeting the special conditions below:

- The article must be made using materials sourced from the entrant's collection of previously acquired goods ie their stash of left-overs or "could be useful" things.
- The article must be made from all new materials.
- The article can be made using any needlework technique including crochet, knitting, sewing, embroidery or any combination of techniques.
- The entrant must declare that nothing was purchased to create the article ie there was zero-cost in making the article.
- Usual size limits apply for the finished article eg max 145*145cm for a rug.

The Stewards of the Needlework Section of the Mt Gravatt Show would like to encourage all needleworkers to enter their work in the Show. The variety of techniques, textiles and colours

displayed always reflects the wide range of ages and interests of our community. Prizes are only awarded to entries judged worthy of recognition, however all entries can, and do, inspire others to be creative through needlework.

To enable as many participants as possible, there are no entry fees for the competition. Prizes will comprise certificates and ribbons at least. Goods or monetary prizes may be given in addition, depending on the sponsorship received. However, the judging of entries is by qualified needlework judges, from The Country Women's Association and/or The Embroiderers' Guild of Queensland.

FAQ

Q: How do I enter?

A: You can either enter online via the website or download the form and send the completed form via email.

Q: I can't drop my entries off on the specified delivery dates, can I drop them off earlier?

A: Yes, you can, by contacting the Show Office to arrange a suitable time. Please ensure that you have attached an Exhibitor's Label (your name, the class category for your entry) to the back of the article using a safety pin AND provide a printed entry form when delivering the article.

Q: What if I can't collect my article/s on the Sunday 27th 3:00pm- 5.00pm?

A: Anything not collected during that time can be collected from the Show Society Office during their Show Office hours in the following week after the Show.

Q: What if I can't collect my article in person?

A: If someone is collecting your article/s on your behalf, please ensure they can provide proof of the article's entry receipt for collection. Failure to do so will result in them not being able to take the article with them.

Q: Will I get charged to come into the Show to collect my article?

A: If you enter the Showgrounds before 3pm you will be charged an entry fee, however if you enter after 3pm your entry will be free.

DISPLAY OPENING HOURS

Articles entered in the Competition will be displayed in the Upper Community Hall during the Show's building opening hours. Saturday 9am-6pm and Sunday 9am-4pm.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entries must include some aspect of needlework e.g. sewing, knitting, embroidery, crochet.
2. Entries must be registered and delivered prior to the dates and times stated in this schedule.
3. All articles must be the work of the entrant who is an amateur needleworker.
4. No article that has won a prize at The Mt Gravatt Show previously may be entered.
5. Used, worn or dirty articles will not be accepted. Articles that have been cleaned because that is a requirement of the craft e.g. patchwork, crochet doilies, will be accepted. Articles may have been ironed.
6. Each article must have a label giving the class number and name of the entrant. The label must be attached to the article and hidden from judges' view, preferably using a safety pin.
7. Entries containing multiple parts (e.g. bonnet & booties) must have the individual pieces attached together, preferably using safety pins.
8. No entry may be attached to cardboard or wrapped in cellophane (mounted).
9. Edgings must be sewn to an appropriate article e.g. hanky, towel (attached).
10. Size limits indicated will be strictly enforced as there is limited display space. Oversized articles will not be accepted. Frames must be smaller than 45*45cm; everything else smaller than 145*145cm.
11. The class an article is entered in may be changed at the Stewards' or Judges' discretion.
12. All reasonable care will be exercised in handling all articles, but no responsibility is accepted by the Mt Gravatt Show Society.
13. Articles may be photographed for the use of The Mt Gravatt Show Society, including publication.
14. The Rules and By-Laws of The Mt Gravatt Show Society, and the Queensland Chamber of Agriculture Societies are available in full via their websites. Entry in this competition implies acceptance of these rules.
15. Any entry not collected after 30 days of the termination of the show will become the property of the Show Society and may be disposed of as the management committee directs.
16. All care will be taken at the show, BUT the insurance will be the responsibility of the competitor.
17. All decisions of the Judges of the Mt Gravatt Show are final and are not subject to review.
18. All complaints must be directed to the Chief Steward.
19. A competition entry may be photographed for the purpose of the Show Society, including publication.

All Competitors enter these events at their own risk. Neither the Organising Committee, Mt Gravatt Show Society, Mt Gravatt Showgrounds nor the owners of the property accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to owners, grounds, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.

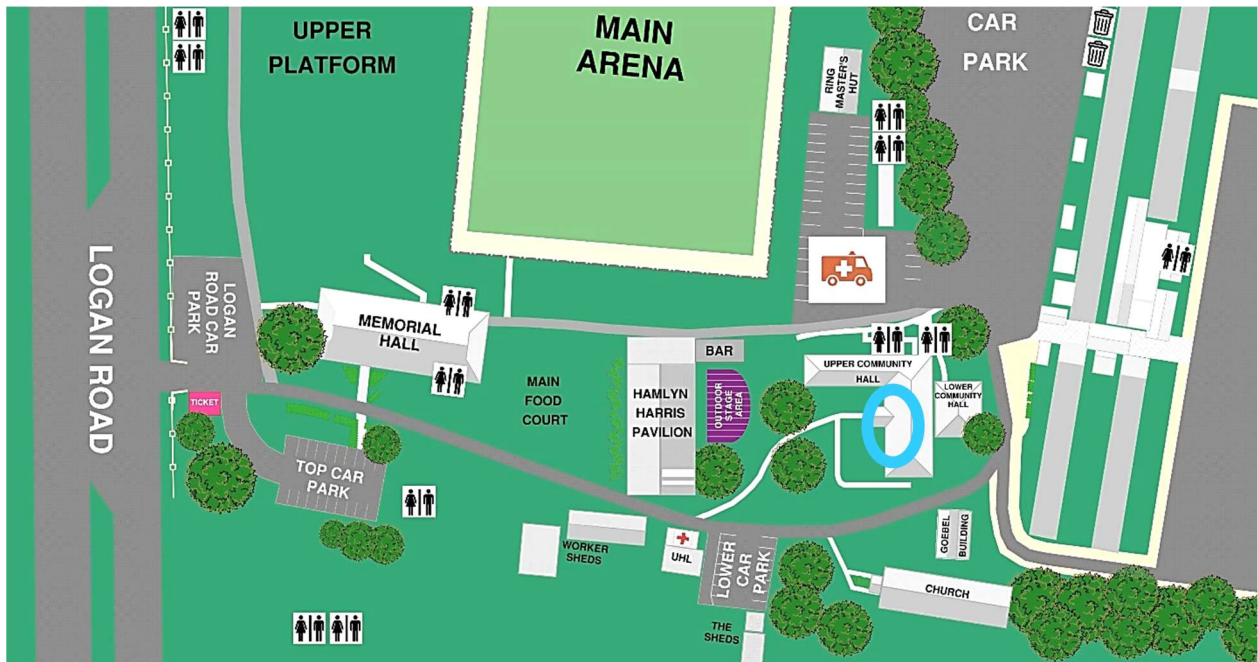
