CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All exhibitors should refer to the General Competition Regulations as provided by the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Society's Inc and applicable Society/Association.
2. No item to exceed 35cm in any dimension, however, exceptions are allowed in some classes. If unsure, contact Steward.
3. An entry must have the competitors name hidden from sight from the judges.
4. Any entry not collected after 30 days of the termination of the show will become the property of the Show Society and may be disposed of as the management committee directs.
5. Each entrant may have up to three (3) entries per class.
6. All care will be taken at the show, but the insurance will be the responsibility of the competitor.
7. The Show Society reserves the right to place in their correct classes, any articles considered entered in the wrong class.
8. If items are for sale, display the sale price, otherwise NFS.
9. Entries are restricted to amateurs only. Teachers or Tutors, who receive income from their art, are NOT eligible to enter.
10. All complaints must be directed to the Steward.
11. A competition entry may be photographed for the purpose of the Show Society, including publication.
12. The committee reserves the right to alter the program and classes at their discretion.
13. The judge's decision will be final, except that the Committee reserves the right to consider a protest lodged in accordance with the Society's conditions.

All Competitors enter these events at their own risk. Neither the Organising Committee, Mt Gravatt Show Society, Mt Gravatt Showgrounds nor the owners of the property accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to owners, grounds, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.

DESIGN CRITERIA

Design 25 points	Proportion and perspective, line, centre of interest, suitability of purpose, choice of material, aesthetic appeal, artistic appeal and original design concept.
Workmanship & Technique 30 points	Evidence of good technique, clean edges and corners, accuracy, thicknesses (consistent where appropriate), matching surfaces, grain/directional alignment.
Degree of Difficulty 20 Points	Actual degree of difficulty. Use of advanced or non-standard techniques. Complexity.
Finish 25 points	Absence of marks (glue, fingerprints, sanding), even finish, dust free, good feel and texture, appropriate for the entry.
Total 100 points	<i>The Judges slips will be tallied up and the entry with the highest points will be awarded the prize.</i>

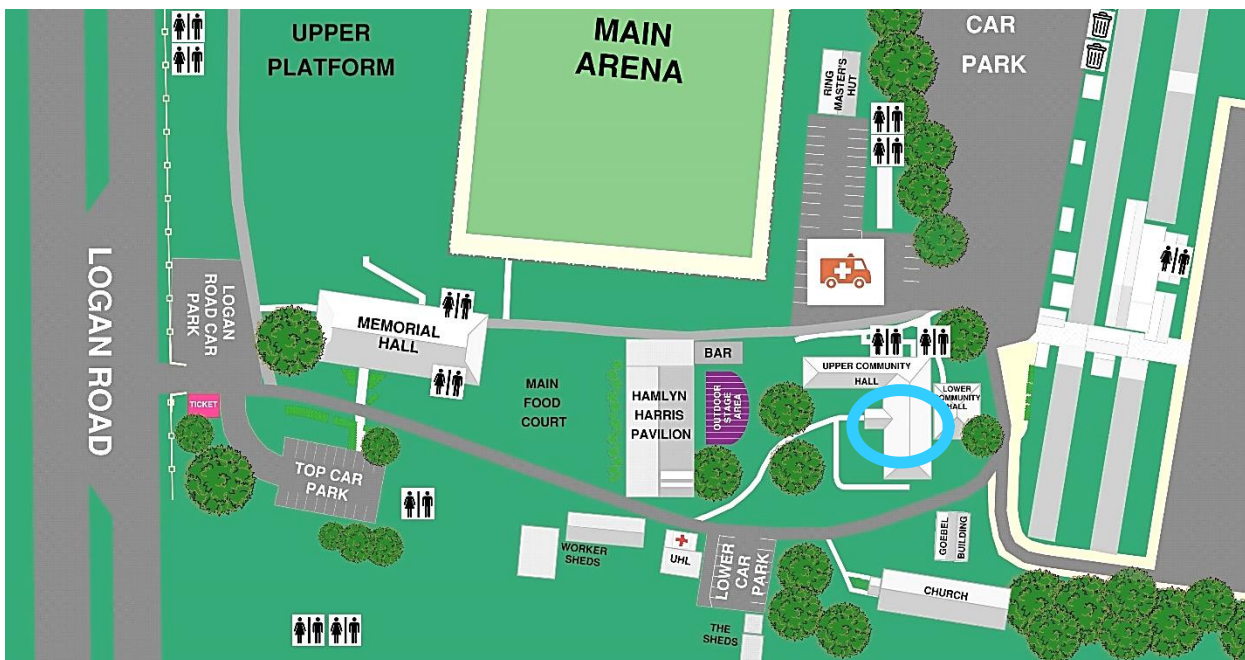

FAQ

Q: How do I enter?

A: You can either enter online via the website or download the form and send the completed form via email.

Q: Can I enter more than 1 article?

A: You can enter up to 3 items in a category.

Q: I can't drop my entries off on the specified delivery dates, can I drop them off earlier?

A: Yes, you can by contacting the Show Office to arrange a suitable time. Please ensure that you have attached the Exhibitors Label (title of the artwork, class category of your entry, your name, contact number, email address and price (if the artwork is for sale) on the back of the artwork) along with the completed entry form when delivering the article/artwork.

Q: What if I can't collect my article/s on the Sunday 27th 3:00pm-4:30pm?

A: Anything not collected during that time can be collected from the Show Society Office during their Show Office hours in the following week after the Show.

Q: What if I can't collect my article in person?

A: If someone is collecting your article/artwork on behalf of you please ensure they can provide proof of the Artwork Entry Receipt on collection. Failure to do so will result in them not being allowed to take the Artwork with them.

Q: Will I get charged to come into the Show to collect my article?

A: If you enter the Showgrounds before 3pm you will be charged an entry fee, however if you enter after 3pm your entry will be free.

CATEGORIES

- Class 1 **Decorative Painting** – Decorative Painting
- Class 2 **Fabric Painting** – Any design on T Shirt or Tote bag.
- Class 3 **Mosaic/Tile Work** – Self-supported.
- Class 4 **Glass Painting** – Any item. Liquid line is used.
- Class 5 **Hand-painted Porcelain** – Must be on porcelain or bone china. Bowls, Vase, Plate.
- Class 6 **Ceramics, Fired item** – Wheel thrown.
- Class 7 **Ceramics, Fired item** – Coiled or other hand built.
- Class 8 **Ceramics, Any item** – Non-fired (including air dried clay).
- Class 9 **Macrame, Plant Hanger etc** – Macrame knots, no weaving – beads can be used (Max size not to exceed 60cm).
- Class 10 **Macraweave** – Minimum of 3 knot styles or thread colours (Max size not to exceed 60cm).
- Class 11 **Paper Tole, Open** – Special Techniques include a combination of feathering and bark.
- Class 12 **Paper Tole, Novice**
- Class 13 **Decoupage, Functional item**
- Class 14A **Scrapbooking** – Family & Friends (2 Page plastic sleeve).
- Class 14B **Scrapbooking** – Great Outdoors (2 Page plastic sleeve).
- Class 15 **Cards, Parchment card with envelope.**
- Class 16 **Cards, Quilling card** – Any quilling technique (Must be paper only).
- Class 17 **Cards, Other** – Any style and technique.
- Class 18 **Diamond Dot Painting**
- Class 19 **Jewellery** – Necklace, Earrings, Bracelet, Beads
- Class 20 **Mixed Media** - Any Article on solid base (canvas, chipboard, wood) (must include at least 3 techniques).
- Class 21 **Any Other Craft**
