## TRUCK & TRAILER ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Showgrounds Address: 1644 Logan Rd, Mt Gravatt Qld 4122  
Entry via Broadwater Road gate only, once through the main gate turn right in to Gate 2.  
Please follow all signs to the designated parking & judging areas.  
Gate 2 will be open from 7am.

All competitors must pay entry to the Show, buy online in advance & save.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All exhibitors should refer to the General Competition Regulations as provided by the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Society's Inc and applicable Society/Association.
2. All exhibitors to have public liability insurance and to have same endorsed for travelling to shows.
3. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that the leaders of their stock in judging rings and parades are capable of exercising control over animals in their care.
4. Children under 12 years of age leading cattle in the Grand Parade are to be accompanied by an adult.
5. Stewards have the right to remove any animal from the judging ring if that animal is a danger to the safety of the public.
6. Chief Steward had the power to remove exhibitors or other persons from the vicinity of the judge while judging. Any persons causing a nuisance, after being cautioned, will be expelled from the Showgrounds. Exhibitors may be disqualified.
7. Exhibitors shall at all times behave in a proper and courteous manner to Judges, Show Officials and other exhibitors.
8. Should an exhibitor behave in an offensive or improper manner; the chief Steward has the right to exclude and disqualify them.
9. Even though all care is taken, Mt Gravatt Agricultural Horticultural & Industrial Society cannot accept responsibility for losses or damage to livestock or property.
10. The administration of drugs is prohibited as per QCAS Rules or exhibitors must have Statutory Declaration signed by a Vet.
11. Suitable attire (Including safe footwear) must be worn when entering the ring.
12. Any person deemed not suitably attired will be asked to leave the ring.
13. Only vehicles transporting livestock with exhibitor passes will be permitted into the grounds. All other vehicles are required to park in the main car park.
14. All competitors must be on the grounds one hour prior to the start of the event.
15. The committee reserves the right to alter the ring program at their discretion.
16. Exhibits that have qualified for Championship, but fail to present when called, will forfeit their opportunity to compete.
17. If the merit of the exhibits in any class or championship is not in the opinion of the judge sufficient to entitle them to a prize, the judge may withhold any prize, all prizes or award a prize or a lower merit.
18. Exhibitors are not to interfere with the work of the Stewards or appointed persons on day. The Judges' decision is final.
19. All prizes not collected on the day of the show will be forfeited.
20. The Mt Gravatt Agricultural Horticultural & Industrial Society reserve the right to change schedule, rings and judges.
21. No spectators, strollers, or dogs will be allowed in the Judging Area throughout the duration of the event.

Neither the Organising Committee, Mt Gravatt Agricultural Horticultural & Industrial Society, Mt Gravatt Showgrounds nor the owners of the property accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to owners, grounds, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.

## IMPORTANT NOTICE

Due to current changes to public liability the following clauses have been included in the Show Society's Rules and Regulations. Please note: When you submit on your entry form you will be agreeing to the following inclusions.

- Agree to compete/exhibit at the 2026 Mt Gravatt Show at my own risk.
- Agree not to make any claim against the Mt Gravatt Agricultural Horticultural & Industrial Society for any injury or loss sustained to me, my property or the livestock exhibit under my care at the 2026 Mt Gravatt Show.
- Agree to compete/exhibit at my own risk and to indemnify and keep indemnified the Mt Gravatt Agricultural Horticultural & Industrial Society, together with any other organization or person involved in the conduct of any show against all claims, suits, actions, or demands, which may be brought in respect of any injury or other loss sustained to me, my property, or the livestock exhibit under my care in the course of competing/exhibiting at the show and agree to exonerate the committee of management of the Show Society together with any other organization or person involved in the conduct of any agricultural show from all loss or injury to me, my property or the livestock exhibit under my care whether due to alleged negligence or otherwise.
- Acknowledge that no insurance is provided on my behalf, and I am responsible for arranging my own public liability and all other insurances.

## MEAT SHEEG YOUNG JUDGES

The winner will represent the Mt Gravatt Show & the South-East QLD Sub-Chamber at the Queensland State final to be held at Toowoomba Show in March 2027.

## CONDITIONS

1. Open to persons 24 years and under on May 1st 2027.
2. Competitors under the age of 18 years must have approval of parent or guardian to attend and it is the responsibility of parent or guardian to make arrangements on behalf of the Competitor.
3. All Competitors to be resident in Queensland for at least three months prior to competition or be attending a college in Qld.
4. Eligibility – National winners and Judges are not eligible.
5. A competitor can represent only one Show Society in any sub-chamber final and only one sub chamber in the state final. Young Judges under the age of 15 years are not eligible to enter state final.
6. A show winner is not eligible to win at any other show but may participate after informing the Steward of previous win.
7. Each competitor will be provided with a card on which he/she will place the animals in order of merit and give reasons for doing so.
8. Cards will be collected by Stewards for presentation to the Over-Judge.
9. Competitors will be required to give an oral explanation of their placings.
10. The judge, in making his awards, will take into consideration the correctness of placing the animals, the dress presentation of the competitor and the arguments provided in the oral presentations

# BIO-SECURITY

## DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE & FISHERIES REGULATIONS

The following conditions will apply to stock and vehicles moving on to the Mt Gravatt Showground. All Queenslanders have a 'general biosecurity obligation' (GBO) under Queensland's Biosecurity Act 2014. Not complying with the GBO is an offence.

This means that everyone is responsible for managing biosecurity risks that are:

- under their control and
- that they know about, or should reasonably be expected to know about.

Under the GBO, individuals and organisations whose activities pose a biosecurity risk must:

- take all reasonable and practical steps to prevent or minimise each biosecurity risk
- minimise the likelihood of causing a 'biosecurity event', and limit the consequences if such an event is caused.

The following conditions will apply to stock and vehicles moving on to the Mt Gravatt Showgrounds.

## N.L.I.S

- All sheep born on or after 1 January 2025 travelling to the show must have an NLIS device applied before leaving property of origin (includes calves).
- On arrival all exhibitors must supply to the chief steward the NLIS number for each animal (the visual number on the NLIS tag), the PIC of the property the animals are last registered to and supply a National Vendor Declaration and Waybill, or Queensland Ag Shows Biosecurity Animal Health Declaration/Movement Record & a National Cattle Health Declaration.

Exhibitors should be aware that clearing facilities at NSW/Queensland Border Crossings at Kirra/Tweed Heads and Mt Lindsay are not permanently staffed. Exhibitors should make prior arrangements with the respective Border Crossing Points before commencing their journey.

## STOCK GENERAL

- All entries must satisfy Biosecurity Queensland requirements.
- No animals with signs of illness are to be brought onto the grounds.
- Competitors are required to advise Event Organisers immediately of sick animals, and they are to stop all non-essential contact with sick animals, ensuring that children do not have close contact.
- Everyone handling animals should wash or sanitise hands between contact with other animals.
- All sheep must be tick free. It is the responsibility of the owner or person in charge of the stock to contact their nearest Department of Agriculture and Fisheries biosecurity inspector and arrange for treatment (where necessary) of their stock according to statutory requirements.
- Mt Gravatt Showgrounds does not have an approved livestock spraying facility. Exhibitors returning to the Cattle Tick protected and free areas will need to contact the DPI and book in for a return treatment. A minimum of 48 hours' notice is required.

## JOHNE'S DISEASE

For Bovine Johne's Disease It is your General Biosecurity Obligation as the exhibitor NOT to knowingly spread the disease. Any animal from suspected herds that have not yet been cleared by Biosecurity Queensland will not be accepted on to the showgrounds.

Rules:

- Each exhibitor has an obligation to take all reasonable and practical measures to prevent the introduction into, and spread of Johne's disease within, Queensland.
- Exhibitors must not enter animal(s) which are reasonably known or suspected of being infected with Johne's disease, including animals which have been introduced with a significant likelihood of being infected.
- Exhibitors must supply a health statement/declaration that provides information about the health of the animal including Johne's risk. The health statement/declaration must not be false, incomplete or misleading.

**Exhibitors must advise their Johne's Disease status at the time of entry.**

## BRUCELLOSIS

All stud breeding ewes and rams exhibited will be derived from flocks, which hold a current Certificate re Flock Accreditation for Ovine Brucellosis issued, by the appropriate body in the state of origin.
