## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All exhibitors should refer to the General Competition Regulations as provided by the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Society's Inc and applicable Society/Association.
2. Maximum 5 Entries per individual Exhibitor.
3. Bulk entries of 20 entries or more may be submitted by schools.
4. All work submitted must be original work of the Exhibitor and completed in the last twelve months.
5. All entries must clearly show the Exhibit Title, Exhibitor's Name, Class and School Name if the exhibit is a School Entry. Exhibit labels are available on the Mt Gravatt Show Society website.
6. Size limitation, the size of the artwork MUST NOT exceed 70cm (along the longest edge). Please exhibit entries unframed because of weight issues.
7. No late entries or exhibits will be accepted.
8. Every care will be taken with the exhibit, however, in submitting this entry form, the entrant absolves the Mt Gravatt Show Society and/or their Stewards of all responsibility for any theft, loss or damage incurred after being delivered.
9. Entrants agree to allow photographs to be taken of their exhibits for publicity purposes.
10. All prize placings will be at the discretion of the judge.

All Competitors enter these events at their own risk. Neither the Organising Committee, Mt Gravatt Show Society, Mt Gravatt Showgrounds nor the owners of the property accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to owners, grounds, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.

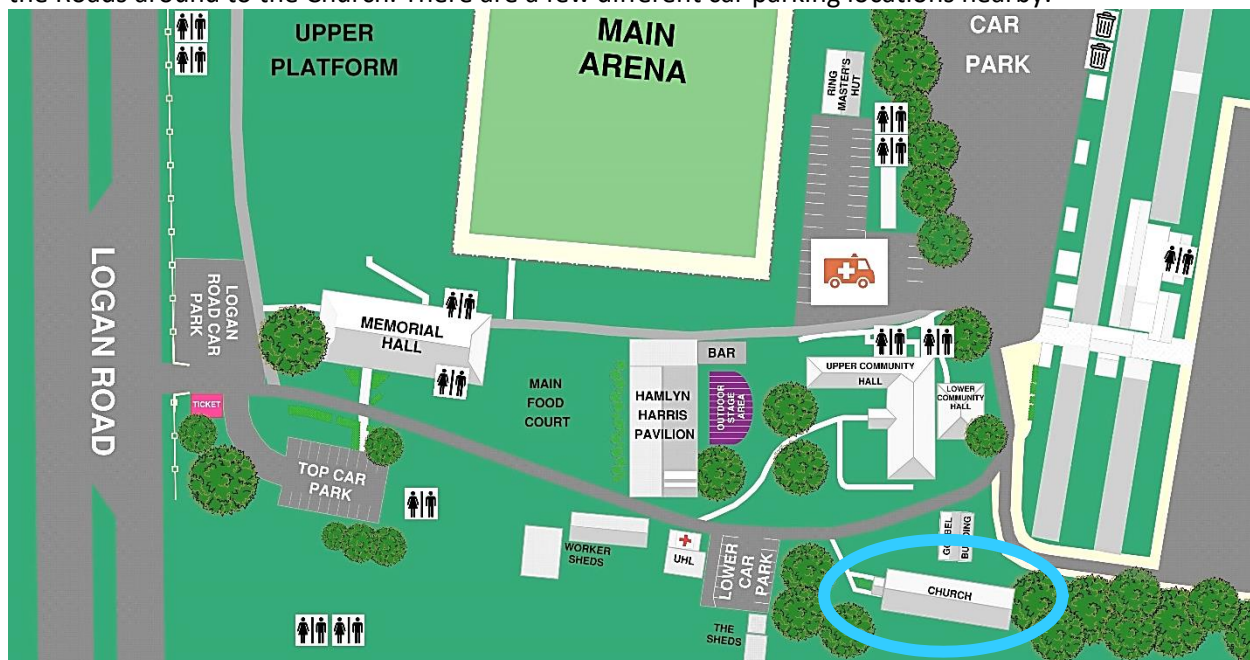

## FAQ

**Q: How do I enter?**

A: You can either enter online via the website or download the form and send the completed form via email.

**Q: I can't drop my artwork/entries off on the specified delivery dates, can I drop them off earlier?**

A: Yes, you can by contacting the Show Office to arrange a suitable time. Please ensure that you have attached the Exhibitors Label on the back or underside (Sculpture) of the artwork along with the completed entry form when delivering your entry.

**Q: What if I can't collect my artwork/s on the Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> 3:00pm- 5.00pm?**

A: Anything not collected during that time can be collected from the Show Society Office during their Show Office hours in the following week after the Show.

**Q: What if I can't collect my artwork in person?**

A: If someone is collecting your artwork/s on behalf of you please ensure they can provide proof (photocopy or photo) of the Entry Form on collection. Failure to do so will result in them not being allowed to take the article with them.

**Q: Will I get charged to come into the Show to collect my article?**

A: If you enter the Showgrounds before 3pm you will be charged an entry fee, however if you enter after 3pm your entry will be free.
